



This is the tenth message from the Financial Services Council about future changes coming to financial advice regulation. *The FSC's goal is to highlight key things you need to know about the Financial Services Legislation Amendment Bill (FSLAB), its regulations and the Code of Conduct for Financial Advice.*

Launching the FSC Advice Regulation Hub

Since March 2018, we've sent regular updates containing the latest information about the changing regulations for financial advice. Over this time, details were released, and updated, and we know a lot more now than we did then.

The RBNZ/FMA conduct reports and the Australian Royal Commission final report have created a stir in the media. In May MBIE plan to release a separate options paper related to these recommendations in parallel with the Insurance Contract Law Review. In the meantime, advice law and regulation change will continue as planned.

This message launches the new Financial Services Council Navigating Regulation Hub (navigatingregulation.co.nz). Rather than give you links to previous messages that may be outdated, this webpage contains brief summaries of the latest information available.
