 - c. give effect to the objects of the council (as defined in the FSC Rules); and
 - d. use reasonable endeavours to ensure that its employees and agents:
 - i. are aware of relevant laws and any applicable codes of conduct and standards; and
 - ii. comply with relevant laws and any applicable codes of conduct and standards.
5. Electronic signature: By completing the online application form and hitting send, the applicant has the relevant authority to do so on behalf of their organisation. By entering Director (or responsible person) the applicant has been given authority by each person named.

An application for admission to the Membership of the Council must name the applicant and provide an undertaking that if admitted to Membership, the applicant and, where relevant, any Related Company or Related Companies, agree to be bound by the rules of the Council, the terms and conditions of their Membership, any applicable College Charter(s), the applicable Codes of Conduct and Standards and all Relevant Laws, including those relating to subscriptions, levies and for the sharing of agreed project costs.
